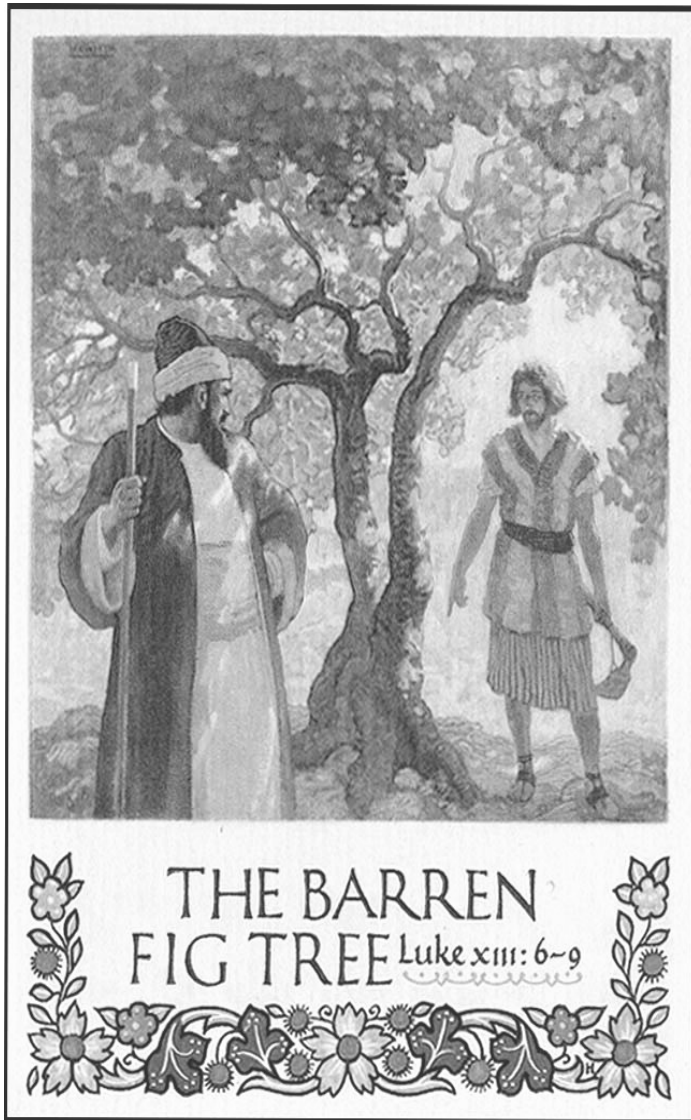

Date Correction – Scrutinies

The Scrutinies of the Elect will be on March 24 & 31, April 7, at the 9:45 a.m. Mass at St. Joseph. The first one is "Christ as the Living Water," the second is "Christ as the Light of the Word," and the third is "Christ as the Resurrection and the Life." The Scrutinies are meant to uncover, and then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect (those adults receiving Baptism, 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation); to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.

Corrección de Fecha - Escrutinios

Los Escrutinios de los Elegidos serán el 24 y 31 de marzo, 7 de abril; en la Misa de las 9:45 en San José. El primero es "Cristo como el Agua Viva", el segundo es "Cristo como la Luz de la Palabra", y el tercero es "Cristo como la Resurrección y la Vida". Los Escritos tienen la intención de descubrir y luego sanar todo lo que sea débil, defectuoso o pecaminoso en los corazones de los elegidos (aquellos adultos que reciben el Bautismo, la Primera Comunión y la Confirmación); para resaltar, y luego fortalecer todo lo que es recto, fuerte y bueno.
