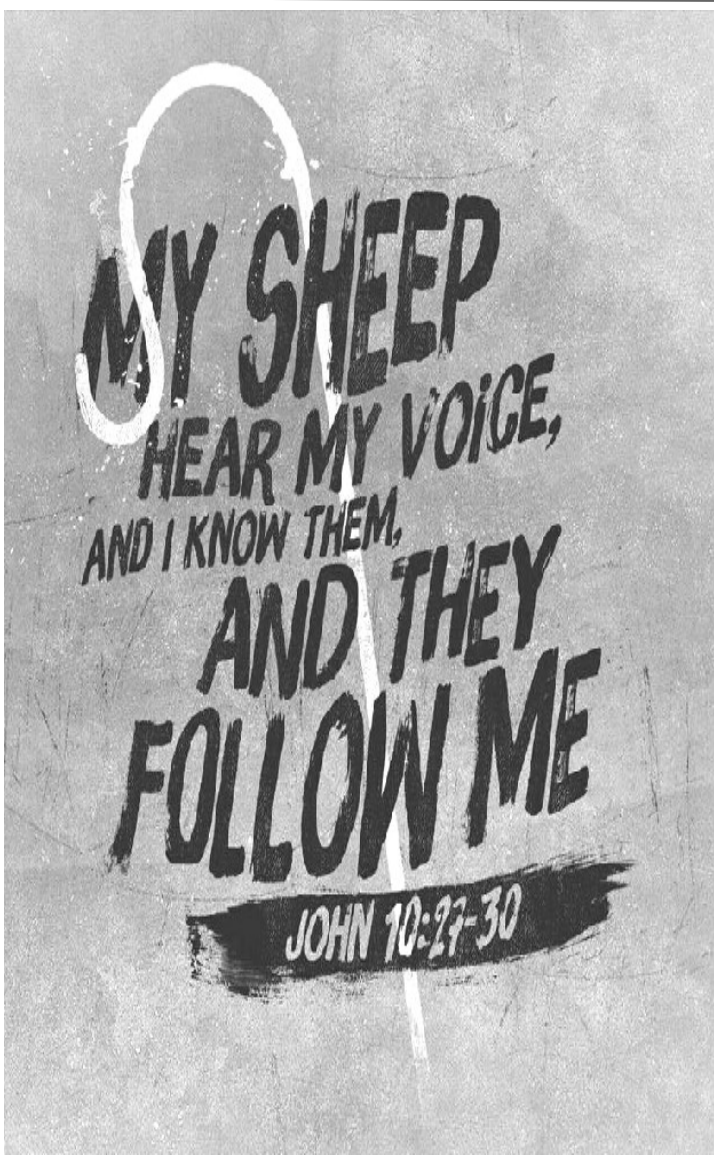

Corazones y Manos

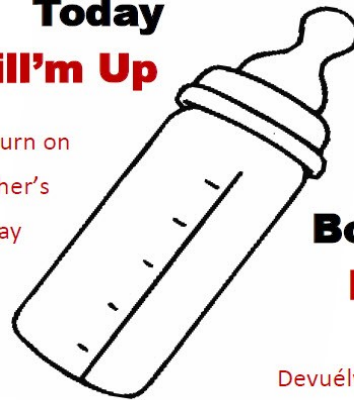

On Monday, May 13th – Pray the Rosary.

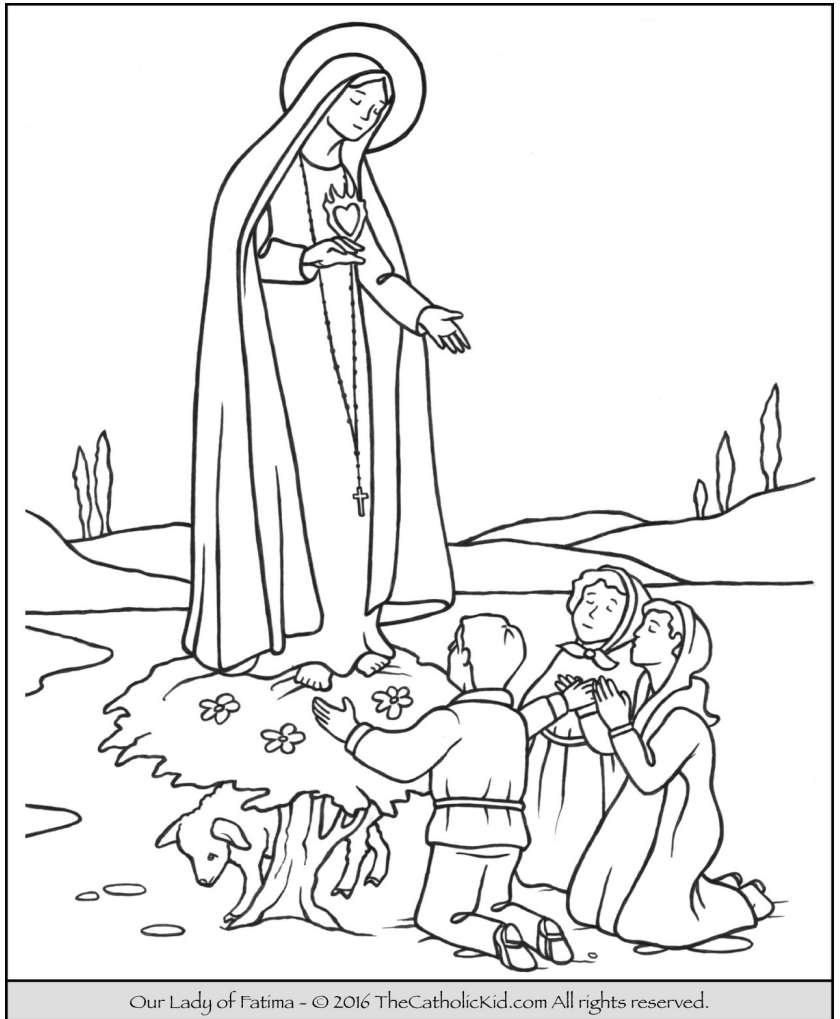
