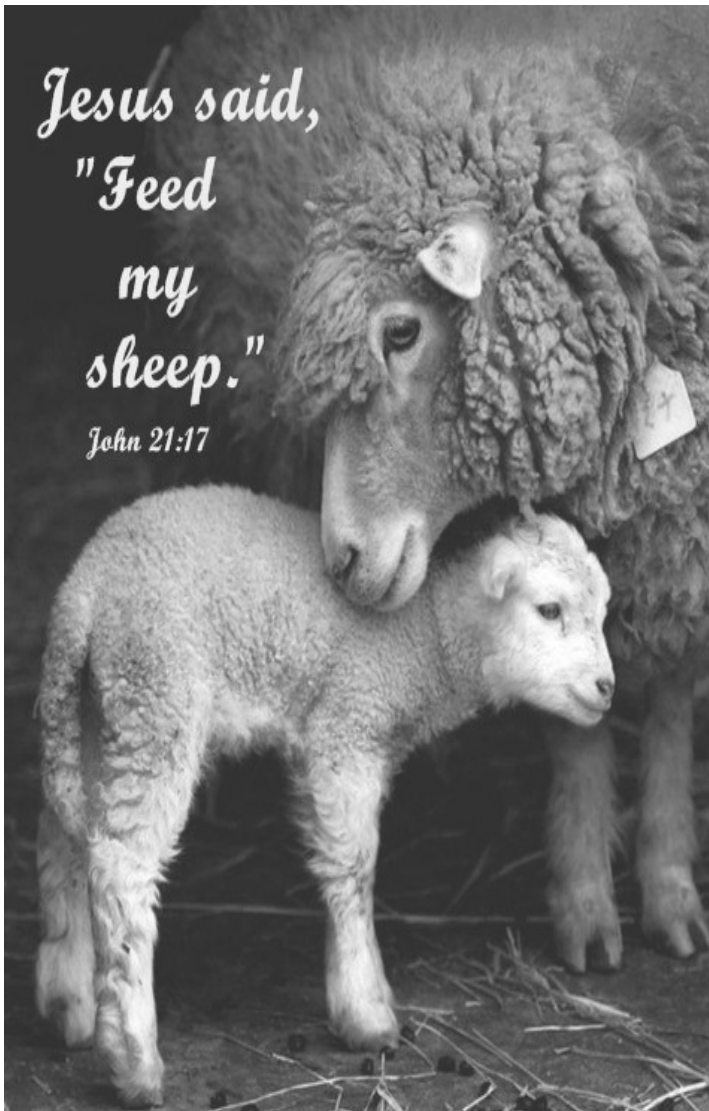

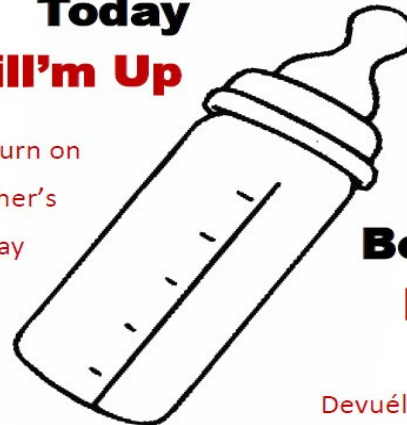

What is the Difference between the Annual Catholic Appeal and St. Joseph/St. John Stewardship?

ARCHDIOCESAN ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

Pledge financial support directly to the Archdiocese in the Spring of each year.

Catholics across Western Washington support this Archdiocesan campaign from May thru April of the following year.

- Donations processed through/and remain with the Archdiocese.
- All funds received in excess of the Parish's Annual goal, which is set by the Archdiocese are sent to the parish identified by the donor AFTER collected funds exceed the Parish's goal.
- Funds not received by donation and/or short of the campaign goal are assessed against and must be paid by the Parish.
- This campaign is in addition to individually directed, Special Collections throughout the year.
- Monthly reminders/Tax Statements provided by the Archdiocese.

Campaign funds provide ordinary income supporting Archdiocese staffing, facility operation and maintenance expenses, administration costs, parish training and over 60 ministries throughout Western Washington including:

- Priests' Retirement & Pension Funds
- Seminarian & Deacon Candidate Services
- Catholic Community & Catholic Relief Services
- Catholic Schools & College Campus Ministries
- Archdiocese Publications, including Northwest Catholic Magazine
- Faith Formation

ST. JOSEPH PARISH / ST. JOHN MISSION PARISH STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE

Parishioners make Financial Commitments directly to the Parish/Mission in the Fall of each year.

Funds are donated to the parish from January through December of the same year.

- Donations are processed by the Parish weekly
- Tax Statements are provided by the Parish annually
- Donations provide Parish/Mission operating income which supports the Work and Ministries of both Churches, such as:
 - Sacramental Preparation
 - Church/Mission, McLaughlin /St. John Hall, Campus Grounds, Repairs and Maintenance, Rectory and operation expenses.
 - Parish Priest and Office Costs
 - Parish Council, Commission and Ministry training
 - Monthly Parishioner donation envelopes and other publication costs

¿Cuál es la diferencia entre la Apelación Católica Anual y la Administración Parroquial Anual del Tesoro?

Apelación Católica Anual del Arquidiocesis

Prometer apoyo financiero directamente a la Arquidiocesis en la primavera de cada año.

Los católicos de todo el oeste de Washington apoyan esta campaña arquidiocesana desde mayo hasta abril del año siguiente.

- Donaciones procesadas a través de / y permanecen con la Arquidiocesis.
- Todos los fondos recibidos en exceso de la meta anual de la parroquia, establecida por la Arquidiocesis, se envían a la parroquia identificada por el donante DESPUÉS de que los fondos recolectados excedan la meta de la parroquia.
- Los fondos no recibidos por donación y / o por debajo de la meta de la campaña se evalúan y deben ser pagados por la parroquia.
- Esta campaña se suma a las colecciones especiales dirigidas individualmente durante todo el año.
- Recordatorios mensuales / Declaraciones de impuestos proporcionados por la Arquidiocesis.

ADMINISTRACIÓN DE LA PARROQUIA DEL TESORO

Parroquia de San Jose y Mision de San Juan

Los feligreses hacen compromisos financieros directamente con la Parroquia/Misión en el otoño de cada año.

Los fondos se donan a la parroquia de enero a diciembre del mismo año.

- Las donaciones son procesadas por la parroquia cada semana.
- Las declaraciones de impuestos son proporcionadas por la parroquia anualmente
- Las donaciones proporcionan ingresos operativos de la parroquia/misión que apoyan el trabajo y los ministerios de ambas iglesias, tales como:
 - Preparación Sacramental
 - Iglesia/Misión, McLaughlin/Salon de San Juan, los terrenos, Reparaciones y Mantenimiento, Rectoría y gastos de operación.
 - Sacerdote parroquial y costos de la oficina
 - Consejo Parroquial, Comisión y Ministerio de Formación.
