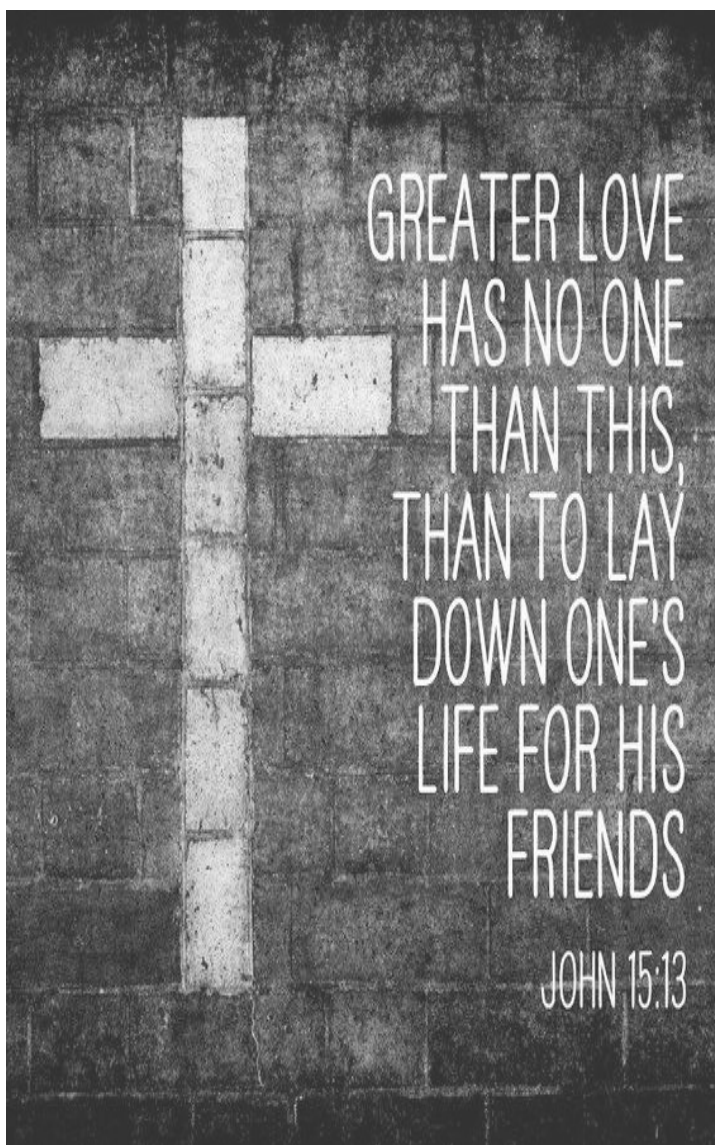

Father Michael Wagner passed away on May 2, 2018, in Tacoma. He was born September 4, 1969, in Poland. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 11, 2011, by Archbishop J. Peter Sartain at St. James Cathedral in Seattle.

Father Michael shared his love for God and his deep Catholic faith with us (St. Joseph's Parish and St. John's Mission) from 2014 to 2017, for which we are grateful. In addition, Father Michael served parishioners as parochial vicar at St. Michael's Parish in Olympia (2013-2014) and St. Mary Magdalen Parish in Everett and St. John Mission in Mukilteo (2011-2013). Most recently, he served as priest administrator at Holy Rosary and Visitation parishes in Tacoma.
