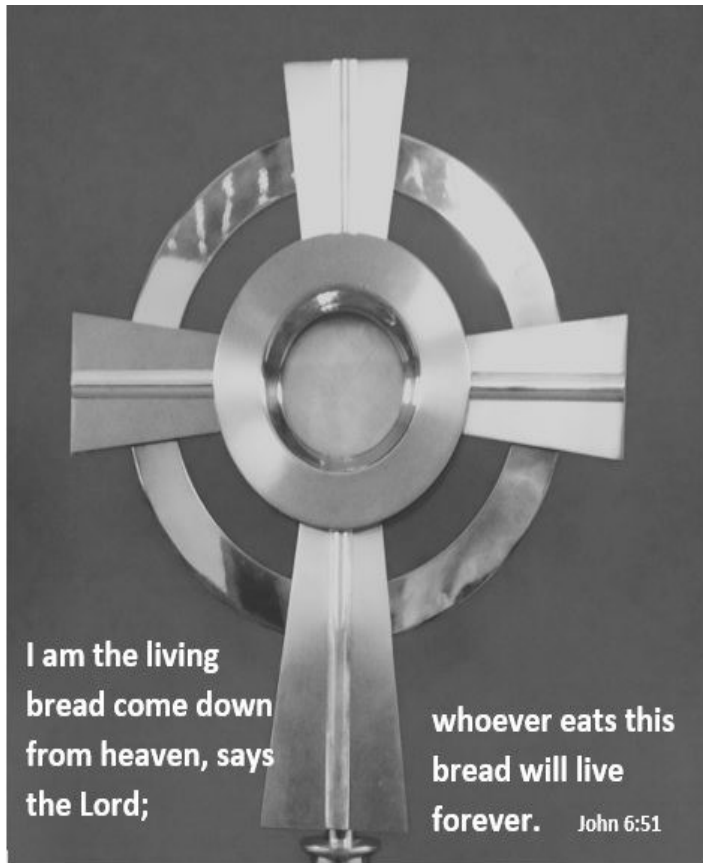

The Miracle of the Feast of Corpus Christi. In 1263, Peter of Prague, a German priest, stopped at the town of Bolsena as he made his way to Rome on a pilgrimage. Peter was struggling with apathetic practices of congregants and irreverent and immoral clerics. He was also experiencing a crisis of his personal beliefs about the Church's teachings regarding the Holy Eucharist. The Church's explanation of the supernatural transformation at consecration that turned bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ during the Mass was becoming more difficult for Father Peter to embrace. Peter was very conflicted and asked God to increase his faith. Peter later celebrated Mass at the tomb of St. Christina. During the consecration, blood appeared from the host, fell on Father Peter's hands and onto the corporal placed on the altar. The sight of the blood and Father Peter's fear caused him to try to hide what was happening at the altar. When the priest composed himself he realized what was happening. He turned to the congregation to share the miraculous event. Father Peter wrapped the host in the corporal and in another protective linen and immediately left the altar to travel ten miles to Orvieto where Pope Urban IV lived.

Pope Urban examined the host and ordered an investigation of the incident. After receiving all the facts, the Holy Father declared this event a miracle. He ordered the blood-stained corporal and the remaining host pieces be brought to the Cathedral of Orvieto. The relics remain at the cathedral. St. Thomas Aquinas composed the Office for the Mass and Liturgy of the Hours to celebrate the Most Holy Body of the Lord (Corpus Christi). In August 1264, Pope Urban IV instituted the Feast of Corpus Christi.
